Still Life Drawing
Ages YA (13) - Adults

July 24, 25, & 27 Instructor – Ruth Leonard
3 Day Class
1:00 – 3:30

Using ordinary objects as drawing subjects, participants will consider volume, texture, line and light to dark values using pencil, charcoal and ink. The still life objects will be lit to create contrast of values on the object as well as cast shadows. This is a basic drawing class for novices or those with more experience who would like to continue developing more skills and experiment with new materials. **Registration required.** 

This is an icon of the Black Madonna, Byzantine in origin from the 13th or 14th century Italy. Either dark faced when painted or darkened from the constant long burning of church candle wax. Original icons are done with egg tempera and gold leaf for the shining halos. This adaptation is painted with acrylics but not the less lovely. The traditional image begins with tracing paper. All materials will be provided. **Registration required.** 

Stained Glass – Mushrooms July 27 Instructor – Connie Pruiksma Adults 6:30 – 8:30

The instructor will supply a variety of multi-colored parts for the project for participants to choose from. Each person will be able to foil their own piece. Once the pieces have been foiled students will solder their creations together. If anyone is uncomfortable soldering, the instructor will do it for them. The instructor will also provide a brief history of stained glass. She will show where glass comes from, have a few examples of different textures and colors of glass and she'll also bring some stained-glass books. **Registration required.**

We will approach the drawing by layering materials such as, graphite, charcoal, ink pastel, white gouche and watercolor, allowing its development through the experimentation of materials. Many of the objects will be suggested in texture, color, line, values of light and dark, allowing the larger grouping to take on form of its own. **Registration required.**

Watercolors from the Landscape August 14, 15 Instructor – Ruth Leonard & 17 1:00 – 3:30 3 Day Class

This class is an outdoor series of three watercolor painting classes for adults and teens. Working outdoors from scenes around the library participants will be asked to initially make thumbnail sketches. This is used to compose a painting by looking for simple shapes in the landscape. Ms. Leonard will demonstrate basic watercolor techniques such as, washes, color layering, wet on wet, dry brush, color resist and paint additives. We will spend time looking at the work of each person in order to learn from each other and solve challenges that may occur. Encouraged throughout the workshop will be: accepting the elements of chance, improvisation and trusting one's intuition. In order to see the range of watercolor painting approaches we will look at the work of Lois Dodd, John Marin, Charles Burchfield, Georgia O'Keefe, Berthe Morisot, Emile Nolde, J.M. Turner, Milton Avery and others. The class is open to all levels, encouraging an open-minded and non-judgmental approach. **Registration required.** 

In this workshop, participants will experiment with a range of unusual and interesting materials – handmade papers, found objects, junk mail, magazines, etc. to create a 5x7 mini collage book. Composition, color, texture, shape, and pattern will be considered to create the pages. Bring any collage materials that are meaningful to you, such as photos or fabrics. All other supplies will be provided. Come and have fun! Registration required.
